CBC DENISE MARIE: NAVIGATING THE ORINOCO RIVER TO SUPPORT GLOBAL TRADE

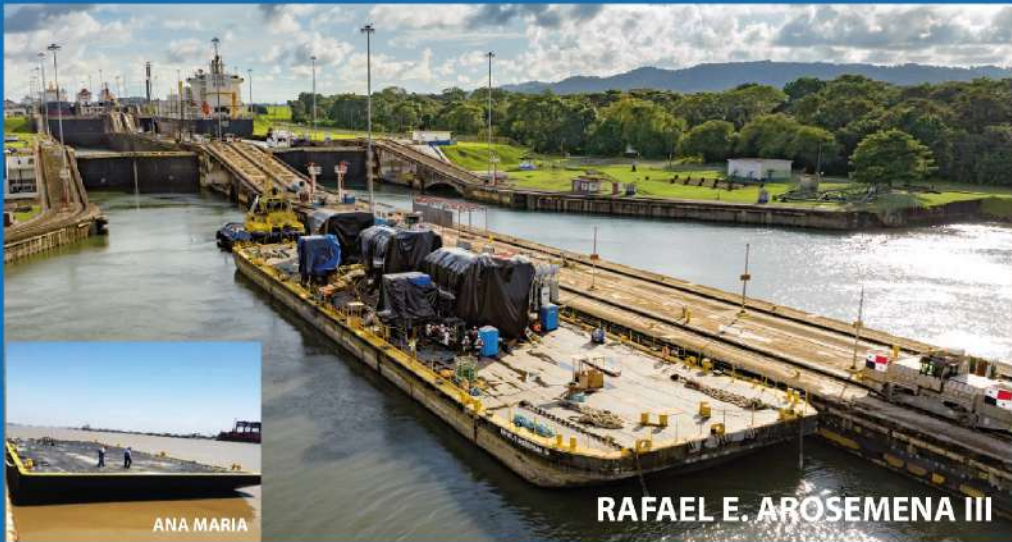
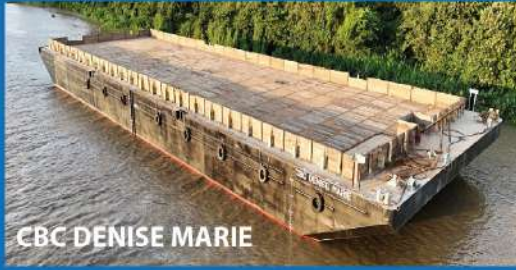

The operation focused on the removal of a vessel that had been submerged for over a decade, occupying prime docking space and hindering operational efficiency.

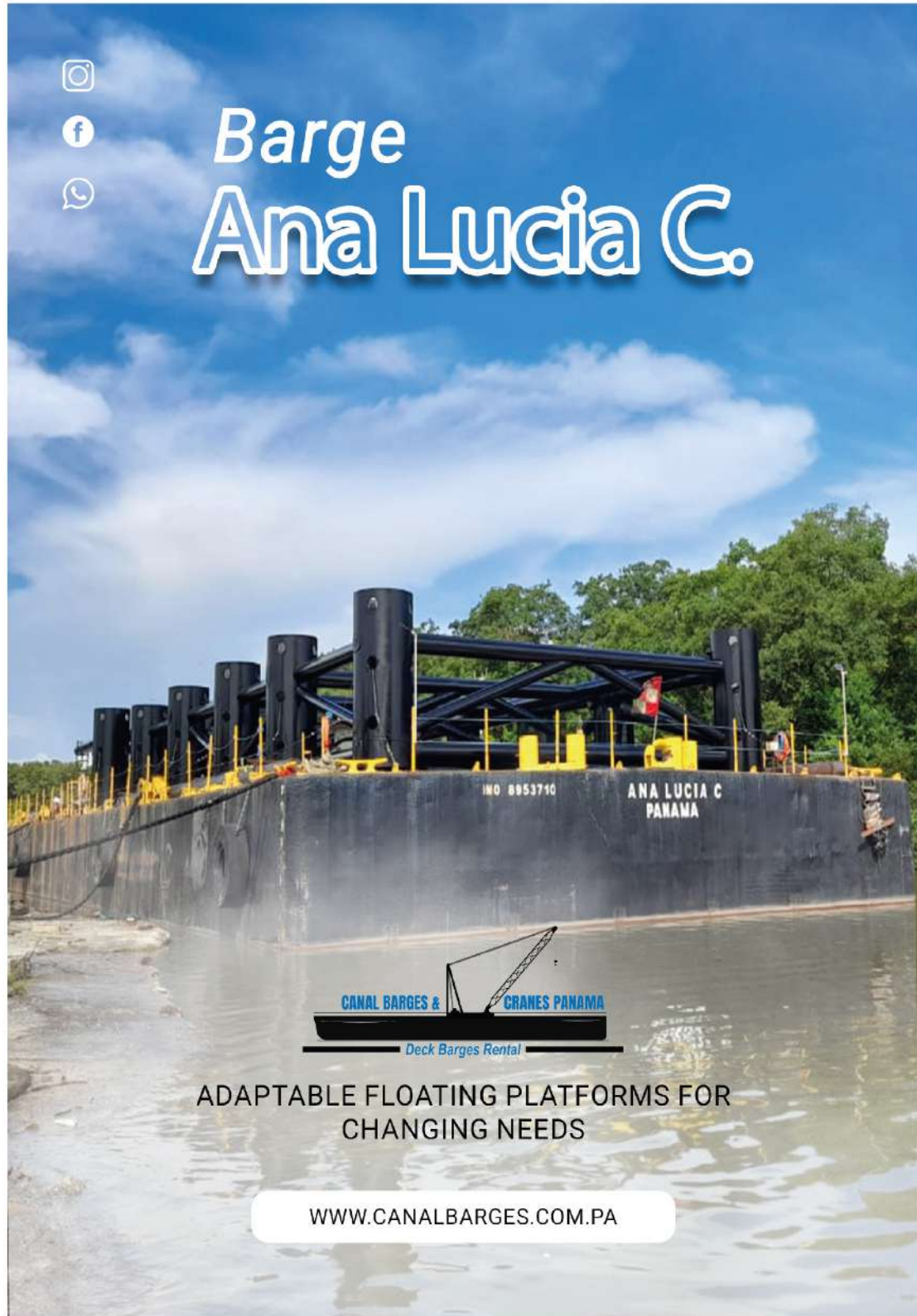
THE REBIRTH OF MR. HUSBAND

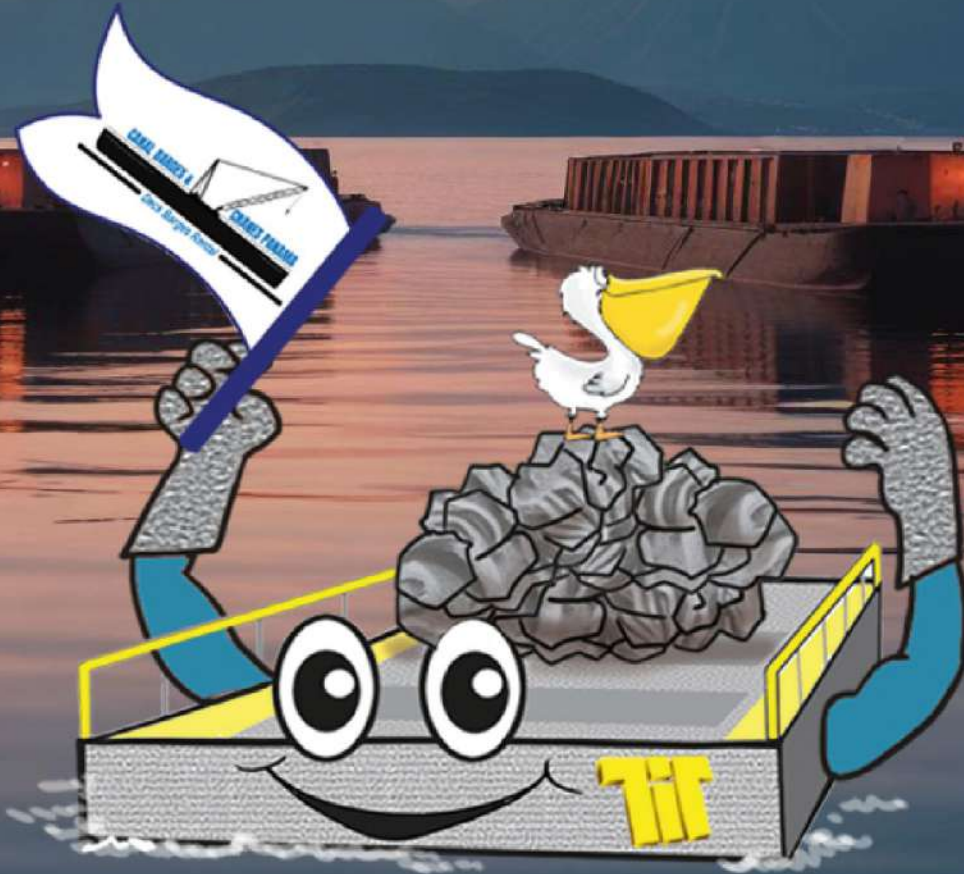
